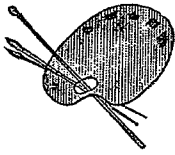


# Supplies for Art



A roll or two of paper towels

A container or replacement packages of baby wipes (we clean our hands a lot!)

A sketch pad-- 6"x9" is recommended, but any smaller size sketch pad will do. Try to get one with at least 50 pages if you can. Michaels or A.C. Moore has a good variety of sketch pads and materials.

A package of #2 pencils

For grades 3-8, A smock (large button-down shirts will do) to be kept in the art room. Please label with your child's name

I am beginning a woodworking class this year. The students are very interested in tools and I have been teaching them the safety rules about using them. I am accepting donations of tools (mainly hand tools) that include hammers, drills, coping saws and blades, screwdrivers, C-clamps, etc. Students will learn how to measure, mark, cut and assemble wood pieces to make various projects including sculptures and frames. aluminum foil (for sculpture)

wax paper

large plain paper plates

small plastic coated paper plates

small butter dishes with lids

paper lunch bags

round headed clothes pins

Cool Whip containers with lids

plastic wrap

plastic storage bags (zip-lock style, any size)

wood scraps (unusual shapes)

wire (easily bendable for sculptures)

small bathroom size paper cups
