

# City Neighbors Charter School

## Founders\* and Founding Members Policy

This document constitutes an agreement between City Neighbors Charter School (CNCS) and the individuals noted below, the parents/guardians involved in the initial formation and start-up of CNCS. As per the CNCS Founding Members Policy, certain parents/guardians may be offered enrollment for their children in CNCS in exchange for time, assistance and physical and/or moral support in the creation and start-up of CNCS. Start-up lasts through the first year of the CNCS' operation as a charter school.

Among other actions requested from time to time by the directors, Founding Members must:

- Sit on a committee and complete projects as assigned in a timely fashion (and by specific deadline, if provided);
- Volunteer time in completion of a project or start-up activity (phone calls, data entry, neighborhood/community partnership building, market research, etc.);
- Make every effort to attend and participate in general and (your specific) committee meetings, notifying that person as far in advance as possible;
- Maintain regular contact with your committee chair/director re: your availability, progress on assigned tasks, and any difficulties you may be experiencing in the completion of your duties.

Remember, being a Member in Good Standing means both doing what you're assigned to do and *not doing* what you're asked not to do. Founding Member Status will be revoked due to:

- Conduct deemed (by the directors) to be detrimental to the mission;
- Failure to comply with any of the above standards.

In the event of revoked Founding Member Status, the children of x-Founding Members would then be invited to participate in the Open Enrollment Period by entering the Lottery (if a Lottery is necessary).

As a Founding Member in Good Standing, you are vital to the start-up of CNCS. Thank you for making the commitment to do all you can to ensure the school's success. We'll make a difference, together!
